She works with the College of Policing to reduce the incidence of primary and secondary trauma in police officers and staff. Together with her associates she is delivering a national programme of trauma training and interventions.

She has written many articles, papers and book chapters including two books on trauma Workplace Trauma – concepts, assessment and intervention and Managing Trauma in the Workplace.
