EXPERIENCE IN ACADEMIC TEACHING AND TEACHING MANAGEMENT ACTIVITY

In all my courses I combine empirical insights from the many international comparative projects I am involved in with broader theoretical references to past and current international debates.

I envisage an innovative maieutic aimed at fostering independent thinking and the critical use of the analytical tools of sociological analysis. In my classes, I support a mixed-methods approach using both qualitative and quantitative data and framed by an institutional analysis, underlining the importance of institutions in structuring social phenomena.

I like to experiment in teaching, to make use of participatory teaching tools, flipped classrooms and I strongly support an *augmented learning* approach which integrates multiple digital resources in both class and off-class activities.

I was one of the pioneers in online teaching in Italy, developing the first online course in Sociology at BA level (180 ECTS, L40) from 2004 to 2014 and the first Social Policy Management degree at MA level (120 ECTS, LM87) from 2006 to 2014.

I used digital devices also to foster the internationalisation of teaching and developed throughout the years several international online courses including a master (E-Urbs) in *comparative urban studies* in partnership with 7 European Universities and involving cutting edge scholars from all over the world.

These courses aim at introducing BA students (third year) to actual research practices. The focus is on research design, and on how to combine theory and methods (quanti, quali, institutional analysis, innovative methods, ...) to investigate innovatively, and in a comparative perspective, social and environmental issues. I always involved my students in ongoing European projects to show them – hands on – the complexities, but also the extreme potential of comparative research. Courses were held both in German and English and attracted many Erasmus students.

My research interests and portfolio cover several issues related to social inequalities, in particular at the intersection of urban and environmental relevant themes adding a territorial dimension to the analysis of citizenship, environmental issues, youth transitions, migration, poverty, ... I address these issues mainly at the intersection between multilevel governance arrangements, inequality and citizenship. The research projects I have been involved in from the very beginning of my career have always been characterized by two aspects: 1) interdisciplinarity; 2) comparativeness. Whenever possible I tried to investigate poverty, social policies, environmental issues, inequality and segregation, social assistance, activation policies, scalar configurations and multilevel governance, adopting a mix of qualitative and quantitative methods embedded in the understanding of the working of institutional settings.
