# Art. 1 Opening of the selection procedure

The University of Urbino Carlo Bo in fulfillment of the M.D. n° 1061 of 10/08/2021, containing regulation for the assignment of the resources of the **National Operational Program** (PON) "Research and innovation" 2014 – 2020 funded by ESF – REACT EU) within the goals of the already accredited Ph.D. courses (D.M. 45/2013), opens for the Academic Year 2021/2022 (XXXVII cycle) a public competitive selection for the admission to the Ph.D. Programmes for the assignment of n° 24 additional Ph.D. scolarships on the thematics of Innovation enabling technologies and in the broader digital topics (Action IV.4) and on the "green thematics" ecosystem preservation, biodiversity, climate change impact reduction and sustainable development promotion(Action IV.5).

The additional positions available in the call, exclusively attributed for the 2021/2022 academic year, and the list of the bound topics of research and the relative Ph.D courses of the University of Urbino Carlo Bo are as follows:

Should the Examining Commission decide that there are no suitable candidates on one or more research thematics, it will proceed to select possible eligible candidates in other thematic ranks, within the same Ph.D course.The Commission judgement is unquestionable.

The Ph.D. Courses have a three-year duration, starting from December 1st, 2021.

The admission test will be held on the day and at the time specified in the sections relating to the PhD courses attached to this Call (Annexes A).

### Art. 2 Admission requirements

Applicants, without any limitation of age nor citizenship, must hold one of the following degrees/qualifications by the deadline of this Call:

- An Italian degree known as "Laurea specialistica/magistrale" or a degree awarded prior to approval of Ministerial Decree D.M. n. 509 of 3 November 1999, updated with D.M. n. 270 of 22 October 2004, n. 270, and equivalent second level degrees;
- Foreign academic title declared equivalent to degrees referred to in letter a)
- An equivalent foreign academic qualification awarded abroad considered equivalent to the Italian degreein terms of duration, level and area of study, which allows the holder to undertake Ph.D. studies.

Candidates with a foreign qualification compete equally as the other candidates for all available positions of the doctoral courses referred to in this Article.

Applicants failing to comply with the requirements stated in this announcement will be excluded from the selection.

The scientific suitability of the foreign qualification is ascertained by the Selection Board, in compliance with the legislation in force in Italy and in the country where the qualification was issued as well as with international treaties or agreements regarding the recognition of qualifications for further studies.

Candidates holding a foreign academic qualification whose equivalence to a second level Italian qualification has not yet been recognized by the competent academic bodies of an Italian University must request, during the online application procedure, the evaluation of their qualifications and will be admitted conditionally to the selective procedure.

The Selection Board will evaluate the suitability of the foreign qualification based on the documentation attached to the online application and can exclude a candidate should the provided documentation not provide sufficient elements of evaluation.

All candidates are admitted to the selectin procedure, under condition that their applications can be verified as per DPR n. 445 of 28 December 2000. The University may carry out checks about the truthfulness of the declarations and request the submission of original documents at any time during the procedures, even after the beginning of the doctoral courses.

The University may, at any time and by order of the Rector, exclude candidates who do not meet the admission requirements from the selection process.

If the university studies of the candidate are divided into first and second level, the first level degree diploma (Bachelor's degree) and the list of exams taken to obtain the relative title (Academic Transcript of Records of Bachelor's degree) must also be attached.









Certificates are accepted in Italian or in English.

### Art. 3 Application procedure and deadline

Under penalty of exclusion, the application form to the selection procedure, including the mandatory documentation, must be submitted by and no later than October 29<sup>th</sup> 2021, h 13:00 (Italian time), exclusively using the **dedicated online procedure PICA** available at the following link:

The requested documentation indicated for each Ph.D. Programme in Annex A as well as a copy of a valid identity document must be attached to the application form in PDF format (maximum size of each attachment: 30 Mb).

The application is to all effects of law a self-certification, pursuant to articles 46 and 47 of the Italian Presidential Decree 445/2000 and subsequent amendments, of the data contained therein as well as in the attachments.

Candidates who intend to apply to more than one Programme must submit an application for each chosen Ph.D. Programme.

Candidates must pay the non-refundable **competition fee of euro 30,00**. The payment of the competition fee to the University of Urbino Carlo Bo must be made using the modalities provided by the online application procedure.

Non-EU candidates who have been recognized an **international protection status**, as defined by the Italian Legislative Decree n. 251 of November 19, 2007, article 2, are exempted from paying the competition fee. They must declare such status in the online application and attach the official documentation attesting their international protection status. Failure to attach the relevant documentation will result in the exclusion from the selection procedure.

At the end of the online procedure, the application will be registered. In confirmation of the correct submission of the application, the candidate will receive a communication to the email address he/she provided in the application itself containing the identification number of the application, needed for any subsequent communication as well as to consult the results of the selection procedure which will be published at the link <a href="https://www.uniurb.it/pon-ricerca-e-innovazione">www.uniurb.it/pon-ricerca-e-innovazione</a>, on the page of each PhD programme.

Candidates are held responsible for the correct conclusion of the application procedure.

Any documentation presented by methods other than the dedicated online procedure will not be accepted. No documents must be sent nor delivered to the Ph.D. Office.

Applications which are at the stated deadline have not been correctly concluded (not submitted, in the absence of due payment or submitted in any different way other than the online procedure outlined above) will not be considered for the selection procedure.

Complaints related to potential problems due to a system overload close to the deadline will not be taken into consideration. Candidates are therefore strongly invited to complete the application form, to pay the competition fee and to submit the application well in advance of the deadline to avoid running into any technical problems.









Once submitted, the online application will no longer be editable. The candidate can withdraw the application using the dedicated procedure on the PICA platform and submit a new application, paying again the competition fee.

Candidates with a qualification obtained in an EU country may submit the Diploma Supplement.

Candidates with a qualification obtained in a non-EU country may submit the declaration of value, issued by the Italian diplomatic representations of the country to which the institution that issued the qualification belongs.

#### 3.2 Candidates with disabilities or Specific Learning Difficulties (SpLD)

According to the Italian law number 104 of February 5th 1992 and subsequent amendments and additions, and Law number 170 of October 8th 2010, candidates with disabilities or Specific Learning Difficulties (SpLD) can request extra time and/or assistance during the selection procedure.

Once the candidate has submitted the application form, he/she can request extra time and/or assistance using the dedicated section of the online procedure and providing a medical certificate supporting the validity of the request.

Documentation that can be presented to request personalized support includes:

- Certification pursuant to Italian Law 104/1992 (issued no longer than 3 years ago)
- Civil disability certification
- SpLD certification (issued by structures of the National Health Service or by specialists and structured accredited for this purpose).

Candidates with disabilities or with specific learning disabilities (SpLD) residing in foreign countries must present a certification attesting the status of disability or SpLD issued in the country of residence accompanied by a sworn translation into Italian or English.

Based on the documentation provided and, if necessary, following an interview with dedicated staff and with methods to be agreed upon, adequate support for the selection procedure will be foreseen.

### Art. 4 Selection procedure

The selection consists of the evaluation of the curriculum vitae et studiorum and of the research project, and of a video-conference interview, including the foreign language test.

The evaluation of qualifications and of the project proposal presented is carried out by the Commission of selection before the oral exam (interview).

The final score is given by the sum of the points reported in the evaluation of the documentation and the oral exam.

The oral exam will consist in the presentation and discussion of the research project, in the verification of knowledge relating to the disciplines in which the topic of the proposed research is inserted and in the verification of knowledge of the English language (see Annex A of the individual PhD courses). The evaluations will be published in the final ranking.

In order to qualify, it is necessary to report at least 21 points in the evaluation of the oral exam.

The project proposal must comply with the indicated criteria on art. 3 del D.M. del 10 agosto 2021 n. 1061.

The non-attendance of the candidate to the admission test will be considered as an explicit renunciation to the selection.

The admission test is carried out by ensuring an appropriate comparative assessment of the candidates.

#### Procedure for the oral exam in videoconference

Candidates will take the oral exam via videoconference and must ensure the use of a webcam to allow their identification by the Selection Board.









Before the beginning of the interview, under penalty of exclusion from the selection procedure, each candidate must show to the Selection Board the same Identity Document of which a copy has been attached to the application form.

The failure to connect, the unavailability of the candidate on the day or time established or the failure to produce the valid identification document as stated in the previous paragraph constitute grounds for exclusion from the selective procedure.

The University of Urbino declines any responsibility for the eventuality that technical reasons prevent the smooth conduct of the oral interview.

Oral exams, also when carried out remotely, are public.

The results of the oral interviews will be published on the university website, at the link www.uniurb.it/pon-ricerca-e-innovazione on the page of each PhD programme.

### Art. 5 Selection Board

The members of the Selection Board will be appointed in compliance with current regulations and with the provisions of the Ph.D. Regulations of the University of Urbino Carlo Bo.

The minutes of the selection procedures will be sent by the Chairperson of the Selection Board to the Rector for final approval.

#### Art. 6 Ranking

At the end of the selection procedure, the Selection Board will draw up the general merit ranking, or specific merit rankings when foreseen, for admission to the Ph.D. Programme. Candidates will be admitted according to such merit rankings.

In the event of two or more candidates with the same score in the merit ranking, the assessment of the economic condition prevails for the allocation of places with scholarship while for the assignment of places without scholarship the candidate with lowest age prevails.

The Rector, with his own decree, approves the merit ranking declaring the candidates usefully placed in the merit ranking as winners.

The Rector's Decree with the final merit ranking will be published in the Official Register of the University (<a href="www.uniurb.it/alboufficiale">www.uniurb.it/alboufficiale</a>) and on the webpage <a href="www.uniurb.it/pon-ricerca-e-innovazione">www.uniurb.it/pon-ricerca-e-innovazione</a> on the page of each PhD programme.

No private communication will be sent: the publication of the merit ranking shall constitute the sole and official means of communication to the interested parties.

# Art.7 Enrolment in the Ph.D. Programmes

Successful candidates are admitted to the Ph.D. Programmes according to the ranking position and in a number equal to the number of places available.

Winning candidates must enrol within the deadline indicated in the Rector's Decree reporting the merit ranking; failure to do so will be considered as a tacit renunciation.

Winning candidates with foreign academic qualifications must also provide:

1 - For qualifications achieved outside the European Union: copy of the Declaration of Value, together with the degree certificate indicating examinations, credits and marks, translated and legalised









by the competent Italian diplomatic authorities in the country of issue. Failure to provide these documents will lead to disqualification from the Ph.D. Programme. The Declaration of Value can be replaced by a certificate issued by the Italian ENIC-NARIC centre CIMEA<sup>1</sup>, containing all the necessary information to assess the qualification.

**2 - For qualifications achieved in a country belonging to the European Union**: Diploma Supplement in English or a certificate issued by the Italian ENIC-NARIC centre CIMEA, containing all the necessary information to assess the qualification.

Candidates holding a foreign qualification who should not produce the required documentation at the time of enrolment, will be enrolled conditionally and will be excluded from the Ph.D. Programme with the obligation to return the unduly received scholarship instalments, if:

- they did not deliver this documentation within the deadline indicated in the Rector's Decree reporting the merit ranking:
- following verification, the qualification produced did not comply with the requirements of this call.

Once enrolled, non-EU winners must deliver to the Ph.D. Office a copy of their residence permit/card or a copy of the receipt proving that they have requested their residence permit to the competent authorities.

#### Art. 8 Scholarships

The annual amount of the scholarship amounts to € 15.343,28 gross (amount determined pursuant to Ministerial Decree 40 of 25 January 2018), subject to the INPS social security contribution provided for by current legislation. In tax matters, the provisions of art. 4 of the Law of 13 August 1984, n. 476. The scholarship cannot be combined with other scholarships awarded for any reason, with the exception of those granted by national or foreign institutions useful for integrating, with stays abroad, the training or research activities of fellows. Anyone who has benefited, even partially, from a PhD scholarship cannot benefit from it a second time. The duration of the scholarship is equal to the entire duration of the PhD program.

The scholarships have an annual duration and are renewed, subject to the favorable opinion expressed by the Board of Professors on admission to the following year, provided that the student has passed the annual checks of the activity carried out. The scholarship is provided exclusively to those who do not have, during the period of attendance of the doctoral course, a gross annual income exceeding the amount of one year of the scholarship (€ 15.343,28).

The amount of the scholarship is increased by 50% for any period of stay abroad. The periods of stay abroad exceed eighteen may not in any case total of months. а Starting from the second year, each PhD student is ensured, within the financial resources assigned in the financial statements of the subjects accredited under current legislation, a budget for the research activity in Italy and abroad adequate for the type of course and in any case for an amount not less than 10% of the amount of the scholarship itself.

#### Art. 9 Enrolment Fees

Ph.D. students must pay an enrolment fee of € 156,00 (inclusive of stamp duty and regional tax). First-year students must pay the fee when enrolling; fees for subsequent years must be paid by November 30th each year.

### Art.10 Rights and duties of Ph.D. students

In accordance with the D.M. n. 1061 of 10.08.2021, the acceptance of the scholarships subject to this invitation totender requires the carrying out of periods of study and research in the company from a minimum of six (6) months to a maximum of twelve (12) months.

The candidate, from the moment of submission of the application, is aware of the need to carry out, in case of assignment of the position, the planned research periods in the enterprise (minimum 6 months, maximum 12) andthat non-compliance with the minimum undertaking period will result in the withdrawal of the scholarship.

In the cases of revocation of the exchange, provided by the Disciplinary annexed to D.M. n. 1061, and in particular in the cases of:

- achievement of the Ph.D. in a way different from the project eligible for funding, if it was not previously requested and subsequently granted the necessary permission by the MUR;
- failure to complete the Ph.D. course (three years) of the minimum period of study and research in thecompany and the minimum foreign period if envisaged;
- the possible negative judgement of the Board of Professors and the consequent nonadmission to thefollowing year of the doctoral course;
- renunciation of doctorate

The University of Urbino will be able to recover from the beneficiary the amounts received.

Moreover, Phd students are subject to the obligations and benefit from the rights provided by the Research Doctorate Regulations of the University of Urbino.

### Art.11 University Benefits (Regional Body for Student Financial Aid)

In accordance with Legislative Decree no. 68 dated 29th March, 2012, Ph.D. students may use the benefits made available by the Regional Body for Student Financial Aid.
